D. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. 4-22-10 Meeting- Alicia Bayless moved to allow the minutes from April 22, 2010. Seconded by Lauren Best, votes unanimous 7-0.

F. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

1. Surveying peers to assist in identifying goals/objectives of PAYC for this year
 - a. Status report on distribution to PUSD
 - Rim Country Middle School approved the distribution of the PAYC survey throughout RCMS, though PAYC must supply 600 copies. Tyler Aguirre will check with PHS Office staff on possibility of making these copies and if not, Town of Payson would be able to.
2. Media and promotion of PAYC to peers
 - a. MySpace and Facebook presentation to group
 - Dillon Walker presented the PAYC MySpace and Facebook pages. He explained that you can add PAYC as a friend, and that all comments have been disabled. Do not make any Wall comments on these sites yet, until they are programmed appropriately.
3. League of Councils meeting for summer 2010 – Su Connell
 - Su Connell explained that PAYC's information has been sent to be a part of the League of Councils, which is to take place on August 25, 2010 in Glendale, Arizona. Dillon Walker read that PAYC is to take part in the opening session, as well as various mini sessions. A chaperone is to be present at all times, and the price is set at \$60. Mayor Evans said that the Town of Payson would be able to cover any PAYC members attendance fee.
4. Fundraising Activities
 - a. Relay for Life – June 4
 - Dillon Walker explained that PAYC is to be in charge of the youth at Relay for Life, which includes ensuring that at 12:00 am on June 5th, any person under the age of 18 must have signed a waiver, as well as attained a wrist band to insure safety. There is to be a meeting on May 17th, at 6:00 pm at the Payson Town Hall to discuss further details.
 - b. Town of Payson 4th of July Celebration – status on participation
 - A vendor has offered to come in to run bounce houses if PAYC is unable to attend. Item moved to next agenda.
5. PAYC t-shirts and alternative PAYC logo samples
 - Alicia Bayless moved to allow the Town of Payson tree logo and format as the PAYC shirt logo. Seconded by Sam Grassel, votes unanimous 7-0.
 - Sam Grassel moved to allow 'logo 3' as the official PAYC logo. Seconded by Alicia Bayless, votes unanimous 7-0.
 - Alicia Bayless moved to allow 'deep forest' as the PAYC t-shirt color. Seconded by Daniel Conley, votes unanimous 7-0.
6. Summer youth events
 - a. Soccer Tournament
 - moved to next agenda
 - b. Other ideas
 - The idea of a Rock Band tournament was brought up, as well as other sports tournament ideas. Item moved to next agenda.
7. Youth Center Involvement Possibility
 - Ponderosa Baptist Church is interested in PAYC volunteering once the center has been built, waiting for future details. Moved to next agenda.

8. Payson Sprint Triathlon
 - Volunteers have already been found for this event, though if interested contact Mary McMullen.
9. PAYC attendance policy
 - PAYC has decided that there is no need for an attendance policy at this time. Any members that have continual absences will be evaluated and can only be removed by the Town of Payson Mayor.
10. Environmental project opportunities
 - The idea of collaborating with another group/club in town that has an ongoing environmental project was brought up. These included the Go Green Club, Key Club, as well as the Science Club (all take part at Payson High School). Payton Pettet moved to allow PAYC to collaborate with other groups with environmental projects and at a later date for PAYC to begin their own. Seconded by Daniel Conley, votes unanimous 7-0.
11. Future summer meeting dates
 - a. Determine summer dates
 - PAYC is to email Mary McMullen with dates at which they are gone to determine a date for the PAYC summer retreat. Mary will be emailing each PAYC member with selected summer retreat date by the week of May 17th.
