Anthony Smith moved for approval, seconded by Alicia Bayless; motion carried 6-0.

E. PUBLIC COMMENTS – Comments concerning items not on the agenda

-Mary McMullen attended the meeting and commented that it was good to see the PAYC members.

Those wishing to address the PAYC during this time need not request permission in advance. No discussion regarding Public Comments is permitted. Members of the Council may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.01 (G), action taken as a result of the Public Comment is limited to (1) asking staff to study the matter, (2) responding to individual criticism, or (3) asking that the matter be placed on a future agenda.

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F. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

1. Results of PAYC request to promote Tyler Aguirre from alternate to position of PAYC Secretary
 - The Payson Town Council approved the promotion of Tyler Aguirre at their 02/03/11 meeting, validating his appointment as PAYC Secretary. (No action)
2. Distribute new packages for upcoming/new PAYC candidates and review proposed timetable for recruitment, selection, and enboarding. Final decisions to be scheduled for March meeting
 - Dillon Walker moved to allow Anthony Smith and Austin Shannon to speak with STUGO and administrative staff at PHS in order to obtain authorization for a school assembly focusing on the recruitment of new PAYC members, seconded by Alicia Bayless; motion carried 6-0. Dillon Walker moved to appoint Dillon Walker, Anthony Smith, and Daniel Conley to a subcommittee which will organize the PHS assembly pending approval from PHS, seconded by Alicia Bayless; motion carried 6-0.
3. Discussion about all current members and their ending dates with PAYC
 - Daniel Conley has estimated that the 07/14/11 meeting will be the last one he is able to attend before leaving PAYC. (No action)
4. Overview of the PAYC code changes which are scheduled to be presented to the Payson Town Council at the 2/3 and 2/17 meetings
 - The councilors discussed changes scheduled to be ratified at the 02/17 Payson Town Council meeting: extension of councilor terms to 3 years, terms beginning in July instead of January, allowing membership of college students, and broadening membership eligibility to include students of any public, private, or charter high school in the Payson area. (No action)
5. Select a PAYC member as liaison to the Payson Roundup
 - After discussion, there was a consensus that publicity and interview duties should be delegated as the need arises. SamGrassel moved that PAYC forgo the selection of a liaison to the Payson Roundup at this time, seconded by Dillon Walker; motion carried 6-0.
6. Review PAYC Fall Concert summary booklet and suggested improvements
 - Deferred to a future agenda
7. Follow-up on PAYC involvement with Payson area food bank drive
 - Due to late involvement in the Payson Area Food Drive, PAYC collected fewer donations than anticipated. Dillon Walker is scheduled to deliver the donated items to Roger Kreimeyer, PAFD Chair. Su Connell intends to provide PAYC with information sometime near November of 2011 to give PAYC the opportunity to maximize fundraising efforts during the next food drive. (No actions)
8. Potential involvement with Star Valley youth council
 - There was discussion of freely sharing information such as youth survey results with a Star Valley youth council should one be established. (No actions)
9. Potential discussion with Payson area schools to present a student award from PAYC at assemblies
 - Alicia Bayless volunteered to meet with local elementary and middle school staff in order to determine whether the schools will allow the

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presentation of a PAYC student award. If school authorization is obtained, then PAYC can further discuss / move for action. (No actions at this time)

10. Potential partnership with Payson area school clubs

There is a general consensus that PAYC should not be exclusively tied to any single school club, but should keep the option open to partner with various groups on future projects. Sam Grassel moved that Anthony Smith should attend the 02/15 PHS STUGO meeting to provide the various clubs represented with information about PAYC and invite them to partner with PAYC on future projects, seconded by Alicia Bayless; motion carried 6-0.
