## F. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/POSSIBLE ACTION

1. Possibility of more frequent meetings of PAYC (i.e. semi-monthly)
  - Sam Grassel proposed that PAYC should meet on the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday monthly in addition to the current schedule of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday. Austin Shannon moved to begin the proposed semi-monthly schedule in April, seconded by Alicia Bayless; motion carried 7-0.
2. Review 02/17 Payson Town Council ratification of PAYC code changes
  - The Payson Town Council approved the PAYC code changes at their 02/17/2011 meeting. (No Action)
3. Review plan for recruitment, selection, and induction of new members
  - Austin Shannon reported that he spoke with PHS staff about presenting PAYC recruitment information and was told that May would be the next scheduled assembly. Tyler Aguirre and Sam Grassel volunteered to speak with the PHS Vice Principal in reference to presenting the information earlier than May. Anthony Smith moved to have Tyler and Sam speak with Vice Principal Van Zile about presenting PAYC recruitment information to PHS students, seconded by Daniel Conley; motion carried 7-0.
4. 2011 Relay for Life involvement
  - Dillon Walker presented information about the fundraising event to the councilors. During the event, one half of the high school football field is set aside for booths representing youth participants. Tyler Aguirre moved that PAYC should participate as a Relay for Life team and have a booth at the event, seconded by Sam Grassel; motion carried 7-0.
5. Opportunity to raise funds through operation of Little League snack shop
  - Kelli Schwein presented information about a fundraising opportunity offered by Cheryl Chance for PAYC to operate the Little League snack shop for two months beginning in May. The councilors would like more details before making a commitment to the project. Sam Grassel moved to create a subcommittee of Tyler Aguirre, Alicia Bayless, and Lauren Best to contact Cheryl Chance by 03/14 for more information before deciding in April whether to accept the offer, seconded by Alicia Bayless; motion carried 7-0.

  - Deferred to a future agenda
7. PAYC advertising and the revision of the advertising subcommittee
  - Anthony Smith moved that Tyler Aguirre, Austin Shannon, and Dillon Walker serve as the advertising subcommittee for PAYC; seconded by Alicia Bayless motion carried 7-0.
8. Potential use of FES as a community center
  - Closure of Frontier Elementary School is pending. Anthony Smith moved to have PAYC focus on the use of the existing FES structure as a community center; seconded by Daniel Conley; motion carries 7-0.
  - Tyler Aguirre moved to have the advertising subcommittee obtain approval from PHS administration for PAYC to poll the students in reference to the use of FES as a community center, seconded by ???; motion carried 7-0.
9. Review PAYC Fall Concert summary booklet and suggested improvements
  - Deferred to a future agenda
