1. Plan and prepare for PAYC presentation to Town Council on 09/22/2011  
*-All members of PAYC should attend the Town Council meeting on September 22 and be there at 5:30 PM. Topics of discussion to the Town Council will include the League of Cities and Towns, Relay For Life, the fall concert, our new shirts, small fund raisers, and PAYC's future plans to become more involved in the Town Council's endeavors.*
2. Plan and prepare for 2011 PAYC Fall Concert  
*-Setup for the concert is estimated to start at 5:00pm on 10/15. Cousin's and Scoops are proposed vendors. Lauren will confirm this on 09/16 so vendor packets and insurance verification requests can be mailed. The Technicolors will perform pending a sufficient price break. Waiving of vending and advertising fees to Cousin's will be offered in exchange for a lower fee from the band. Tug of war and small miscellaneous games will be part of the event.*  
*-Anthony Smith made a motion to authorize an \$80 limit for Lauren Best to purchase game items for the concert, seconded by Tesia Smith. The motion passed unanimously*
3. Review of League of AZ Towns and Cities  
*-Council members Dillon Walker, Tesia Smith, Austin Shannon, and Michael Scott had a great time and have come back with hopes to expand the involvement of PAYC in the community.*
4. Discussion of possible name change for PAYC  
*-A new name for PAYC was suggested to include more of the Payson area. The idea to make it the Payson Area Youth Council instead of Payson Advisory Youth Council was brought up but the topic was pushed to a later agenda*
5. Proposed "Youth Mixer" event with Town officials  
*-A "Youth Mixer" event was brought up that involves the PAYC members, Star Valley councilmen, and Payson councilmen having a dinner to discuss issues facing the Payson area.*
6. Proposed 2012 calendar of meeting dates  
*-This item has been moved to a future agenda.*
7. Option of an additional PAYC meeting for September on 09/29/2011  
*-Kayla Percell moved to have a meeting on September 29 at 6:00PM to discuss planning for the concert and Anthony Smith seconded. The motion passed unanimously.*
8. PAYC awards at local schools  
*-This item has been moved to a future agenda.*
9. Potential community service activities  
*-Some of the council members volunteered to help paint bathrooms for the Senior Center on September 24 at 3:00 PM.*
10. PAYC advertising  
*-Dillon Walker has finished the concert flier and will bring it to the council for distribution once the Technicolors are officially booked. Dillon walker also is going to email the new PAYC brochure to Kelli for future use.*
