| | 1. Chairman Hunt read the Commission Responsibilities, Powers and Duties verbatim as approved by Resolution No. 2641, commenting it is a comprehensive list. Tim Wright brought up that the new budget by the Commission for the airport should be ready by the end of March, 2012. 6. Comments of Commission Members Airport Vision/Mission.

Henley: Develop the Payson Airport into a showpiece gateway, presenting a great first impression of Payson and the Rim Country to tourists and business visitors. The airport is a major economic driver for Rim Country even if there were not any local aircraft based here.

Nyhus: agrees with above and would like to see more hangars, run-up area, additional runway exits, precision instrument approach and a courtesy car.

Day: agrees with above and would like to see a terminal building that represents the showcase concept and taxiway lighting.

Law: agrees with the above and has concern about encroachment issues around the airport property.

Garmon: agrees with the above and thinks community involvement is an important aspect of the commission with future airport planning.

Hunt: agrees with the above and thinks it would best serve the airport to have individual commission members responsible for particular areas based on their own expertise.
