

ORDINANCE NO. 681

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, ADDING SECTION 93.13 TO THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF BOWS AND ARROWS AND CROSSBOWS IN, UPON, INTO, OR ADJACENT TO ANY MUNICIPAL PARK.

WHEREAS, the discharge of a bow and arrow, or a cross bow can result in damage to property; injury to ducks, geese, and other animals; and bodily injury or death to persons; and

WHEREAS, unclaimed or unattended spent arrows present a danger to both ducks, geese, other animals and children; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council find that the discharge of a bow and arrow or crossbow in, upon, into, or adjacent to municipal parks is an unreasonable, dangerous act; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson has found that the adoption of this Ordinance Number 681 is necessary and appropriate to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Payson as a lawful exercise of police power vested in the Town by the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Common Council to amend the Code of the Town of Payson by adding Section 93.13 of the Code to the Town of Payson for these purposes,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 93.13 of Chapter 93 of Title IX of the Code of the Town of Payson, is hereby added and as added shall read as follows:

§ 93.13 ARCHERY PROHIBITED

- (A) No person shall for any reason discharge a bow and arrow or a crossbow in, upon, into, or adjacent to any municipal park.
- (B) Any person who is found guilty of a violation of this section that causes or results in injury to any person, or to any duck, goose, or any other animal, shall be assessed and pay a minimum fine in the amount of \$500.00.

Section 2. All violations of Chapter 93 of Title IX of the Code of the Town of Payson shall be punishable as class one misdemeanor violations pursuant to Section 10.99 of the Code of the Town of Payson.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance Number 681 is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance Number 681. The Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Payson declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance Number 681 and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion thereof despite the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases or portions would be declared invalid or unconstitutional.
