

SURFACE TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 2, 2006

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- A The duly posted Surface Transportation Advisory Committee meeting was called to order at approximately 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers by Chairman Al Lyons. Meeting Time & Place
- B **ROLL CALL:** Al Lyons, Chairman, Members Ginger Henry, Bruce Van Camp, Roy Kindrick, and Gordon Metcalf. Roll Call

- F **MINUTES:** Minutes
July 5, 2006 Surface Transportation Advisory Committee Minutes. APPROVED, 5-0
Member Van Camp **moved, seconded by Member Metcalf to accept the July 5, 2006 Surface Transportation Advisory Committee Minutes with a corrected date. Motion carried, 5-0.**
- G **Status report and update on street projects by the Public Works Engineer or his designee.** Status Report

LaRon Garrett, Assistant Public Works Director/Town Engineer, stated that the slurry seal would start next Tuesday. McLane Road was still under construction. The storm drain was still being put in and the curb would be poured next week. ADOT was paying for it, but the Town was running the project. There was \$800,000 in the budget for Mudsprings Road. Mr. Garrett needed another \$100,000 to complete the project, which could be picked up the next fiscal year. The intersection of Granite Dells and Mud Springs Road will be a round-a-bout. The Airport Road and Highway 87 signal light price had gone up to \$394,000 from \$388,000. St. Phillips and Bonita Street are still in the budget and construction will start next year.
- H **Discussion/possible action concerning street connectivity in Payson.** Street Connectivity

Mr. Garrett explained the cost estimate to connect Goodnow Road to Highway 260. The Town would have to buy a little over a quarter acre

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of land. The total cost for the project was \$402,103.13. It was Committee consensus to carry this item over to the next meeting. Chairman Lyons asked Mr. Garrett to include a safety study of the area in the cost estimate for the next meeting. It was Committee consensus that the stop signs on South Colcord Road should not be removed.

A Discussion/possible action concerning right turn movements at Highway 87 and Highway 260.

Mr. Garrett drew a diagram of the Highway 87 and 260 intersection showing how part of the island could be shaved off to allow cars traveling north to turn right or continue on north.

Following some discussion the Committee believed there could be safety concerns for pedestrians. Mr. Garrett would ask ADOT to do a study of the area for that project.

B Discussion/possible action concerning updating the road priority list.

It was Committee consensus to take Mudsprings Road, St. Phillips Street and McLane Road and move them to the bottom of the list as active projects and move the other projects up.

Mr. Garrett explained the concerns of the Mayor's Street Task Force. Currently the Street Task Force was walking every street in Payson to assess its condition. The Committee would like to be made aware of any findings by the Task Force.

It was Committee consensus to have discussion/possible action concerning the status report and update, street connectivity, right turn movements at Highway 87 and Highway 260, right of way usage, left turn at Colcord and Main and update the road priority list on the next agenda.


