 June 21, 2006


- A The duly posted regular meeting of the Building Advisory Board was called to Meeting Time order by Chairman Barber at 6:00 p.m. in the Community Development & Place Conference Room.
- B MEMBERS PRESENT: Jon Barber, Gary deSzendeffy (arrived late), Ralph Roll Call Bossert, Herm Holtz, Rob Myer, and Don Monteath . Absent: James Garner.
- C STAFF PRESENT: Ray LaHaye, Building Official; and Chris Floyd, Secretary. Staff Present
- D APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Don Monteath moved, seconded by Rob Myer, to Approval of approve the minutes of the February 22, 2006, meeting, pages 383-385; motion Minutes carried 5-0.
- E OTHERS PRESENT: No one else was in attendance. Others Present
- F Ray LaHaye, Building Official, stated that he has started his review of the updates 2006 Code to the 2006 codes. He said that his review of the residential code was completed Updates and he was starting the review of the IBC. Mr. LaHaye stated that there were some things added to the code but most changes were minor. He commented that the review would be easier because he has all the updates now. Mr. LaHaye also commented that he would like to begin the review of the International Residential Code (IRC) at the October meeting. The format would be to go through all the codes, then have one recommendation on all codes for the Council. Mr. LaHaye stated that he would get the code books to the Board prior to the review process beginning.
- Chairman Barber commented that since the Town has gotten the codes where they are today it would be wise to stay on time with them.
- Ray LaHaye, Building Official, commented that the presentations should be brief but with good content. He said that the plumbing code would be the big change and he recommends the ICC plumbing code.
- G The next meeting was tentatively scheduled for October 18, 2006, at 5:00 p.m. Mr. LaHaye commented that once the code review process begins then would go to monthly meetings and see how much progress can be made. If necessary, then could go to two meetings a month until the review was completed.
