

RESOLUTION NO. 2251

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION(S) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS AND STATE SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION(S) MEET THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION(S).

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson desires to undertake community development activities;
and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG); and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressionally mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within these application(s) address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, an applicant for State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and federal statutes and regulations,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Payson authorize application(s) to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for fiscal year 2007 CDBG funds.

Section 2. That F. Robert Edwards, Mayor of the Town of Payson, be and is hereby authorized to sign application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for owner occupied housing rehabilitation and improvements to the roof of the Payson Senior Center.

Section 3. That the Town of Payson be and is hereby authorized to take such other and further actions as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution Number 2251 and to implement and complete the activities submitted in said applications for State CDBG funds.

Section 4. That this application for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low- and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefitting low- and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight, or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health.

Section 5. That the Town of Payson will comply with all State CDBG Program guidelines, federal statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and certifications contained in the(these) application(s).
