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## RECOMMENDED MOTION

I move to award the 2007 Rubberized Chip Seal Program to Cactus Transport, Inc. and authorize the Mayor to sign all necessary contract documents.

## SUMMARY OF THE BASIS FOR RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Earlier this year the Street Task Force completed their inventory and rating of all the public roads in Payson. Two of the major roads were ranked very low, Airport Road from the end of the new pavement to Vista Road and Vista Road between Mesa Drive and Airport Road. The task force recommendation was to upgrade these roads using a chip seal. This chip seal is similar to the one recently placed on Longhorn Road. The chip seal is a little heavier than the slurry seal and uses a rubberized emulsion.

On July 19, 2007 we received 2 bids for this years program.

Staff recommends awarding the 2007 Rubberized Chip Seal Program to Cactus Transport, Inc. and authorize the Mayor to sign all necessary contract documents.
