A Discuss/Possible Action concerning future street repairs, reconstruction, and/or additions, including recommending a priority for each project.

Chairman Loeffler asked the committee members to please keep in mind the Main Street development, and the future transportation needs of the community while trying to make selections for the priority list. Mr. Garrett discussed the STAC street priorities list. The committee decided on streets that would possibly qualify as first priority; they included Easy Street, Frontier Street, Goodnow Road, Manzanita Drive, McLane Road, Mud Springs (Granite Dells to Highway 260), Rumsey Road and Main Street. The streets that were considered second included Aero Drive (Highway 87 to Ponderosa), Longhorn Road, Colcord Road (Main Street to Longhorn Road), Mud Springs (Phoenix Street to Frontier Street) and Phoenix Street. Chairman Loeffler would like to wait for traffic accident reports before making final selections or decisions.

Mr. Garrett will report on traffic calming tools for volume and speed on Phoenix Street and Mud Springs. Member Tilley would like to add the proposed roundabout at the intersection of Highway 87 and Airport Road.


