

RESOLUTION NO. 2436

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS FOR THE NOVEMBER 4, 2008 SPECIAL ELECTION, FIXING THEIR COMPENSATION, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK TO APPOINT AN ELECTION BOARD AND A TALLY BOARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is provided by law that November 4, 2008 is one of the dates on which the Town is authorized to hold an election; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 743, the Mayor and Common Council called a special election to be held November 4, 2008 ("the Special Election"),

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to appoint an Election Board and a Tally Board consisting of one inspector, two judges, and two clerks for the purpose of processing the early voting and mail ballots from all Voting Precincts in the Town of Payson. The Tally Board shall convene at Town Hall on such dates and times as directed by the Town Clerk. The Tally Board shall assist the Town Clerk in the tallying of the ballots and shall handle any questioned or provisional ballots arising at the Special Election.

Section 2. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized to appoint such persons as she requires, including, but not limited to, those who constitute an Election Board and a Tally Board for the Special Election.

Section 3. The following officers, as selected and appointed by the Town Clerk, and initially set forth on Exhibit "A" hereto, are hereby ratified, approved, and appointed to conduct the Special Election. If any officer cannot or does not serve for either the primary or general election, the Town Clerk shall appoint an alternate or a qualified substitute.

Section 4. The compensation of each of the officers is fixed at the rates per hour shown below for the election; provided that a minimum of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per day must be paid to each officer.

Inspector:	\$12.00/hour
Judges:	\$10.00/hour
Clerks:	\$10.00/hour

Regular employees of the Town will receive their normal salary in lieu of the hourly rates set forth above, subject to the minimum of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per day.

Section 5. The Town Clerk and the Town of Payson be and is hereby each authorized to take and

perform such other and further actions as are necessary or appropriate to carrying out the purpose and intent of this Resolution Number 2436 and to provide election officials for the Special Election.

Section 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution Number 2436 is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

Section 7. WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this Resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Town of Payson, an EMERGENCY is hereby declared to exist, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption, and approval by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Payson.
