

RESOLUTION NO. 2492

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, MOVING THE HUMAN RESOURCES DIVISION TO THE TOWN MANAGER'S DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson ("Town") adopted its Resolution No. 2326 on September 20, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2326 merged the duties of the Human Resources Division into the Finance Department; and

WHEREAS, at that time the Chief Fiscal Officer had human resources experience; and

WHEREAS, the Town does not currently have a Chief Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager has human resources experience; and

WHEREAS, finding candidates for the Chief Fiscal Officer position who have both good financial and human resources capabilities will be difficult; and

WHEREAS, removing human resources duties from the oversight of the Chief Fiscal Officer position will allow the Town to attract better candidates for that position,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All the human resource duties, responsibilities and functions of the Town of Payson are hereby placed in the Town Manager's Department.

Section 2. The Town organization chart is hereby amended to place the Human Resources Division in the Town Manager's Department.

Section 3. The Town Manager shall be responsible for administering the Town of Payson Personnel Policy Manual and all personnel rules and regulations of the Town of Payson.

Section 4. The Town is hereby authorized to take such other and further actions as are necessary or appropriate to carry out the terms and provisions of this Resolution No. 2492.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Resolution No. 2492 is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution No. 2492. The Town Council of the Town of Payson declares that it would have adopted this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one (1) or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, phrases or portions may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. All provisions of Resolution No. 2326 and any other resolution of the Town of Payson in conflict with the provisions in this Resolution No. 2492 are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
