

RESOLUTION NO. 2530

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, URGING THE TONTO NATIONAL FOREST TO DESIGNATE MONUMENT PEAK LOOP TRAIL AS A NON-MOTORIZED PUBLIC TRAIL.

WHEREAS, Monument Peak Loop Trail is a part of the Town of Payson Area Trails System, located within the Tonto National Forest in the Town of Star Valley; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Town of Payson that Monument Peak Loop Trail should be maintained as a non-motorized trail for the benefit and safety of persons utilizing the trail on foot; and

WHEREAS, the Tonto National Forest Service has designated Monument Peak Loop Trail as a motorized trail; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson believes that it is preferable to maintain this trail as a pedestrian only trail,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Tonto National Forest be and is hereby urged to reconsider the designation of Monument Peak Loop Trail and to change that designation from a motorized trail to a non-motorized trail.
