

- A **CALL TO ORDER:** Chairman Van Camp called to order the duly posted Transportation Advisory Board meeting at approximately 4:05 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Meeting Time & Place

Councilman Ed Blair commented on the heavy traffic the Town experiences during holiday weekends. He made a few suggestions for traffic flow through Town. Public Comments

There were no corrections on the May 5, 2010 Transportation Advisory Board minutes. **Approved 4-0.** Minutes
- H **Update from the Board Chairman.**  
Chairman Van Camp had no comments. Chairman Report
- I **Items for Discussion/Possible Action**  
**1. Status report and update on street projects and street budget by the Town Engineer or his designee.** Engineer Report  
Mr. Garrett reported on the roundabout located at Highway 87 and Airport Road. This project has gone to bid and the bids are due back June 25, 2010. And should be under construction by late July early August. A TAC meeting for the PARA study will be held on June 23, 2010 at the Police Department conference room. A public meeting will be held at the end of July in the library. Mr. Garrett reported on the Memorial Day traffic study done by ADOT. He felt the holiday traffic was lighter than normal. Mr. Garrett explained the road safety audit studied five intersection in Payson; Bonita and Highway 87, Highway 260 and Highway 87, Malibu and Highway 87, Wells Fargo and Highway 260, and Manzanita and Highway 260. ADOT saw where the problems are and felt some improvements can be done fairly

simply with signage and striping. The Town and ADOT will have a chance to review the results and make comments before final safety audit report is out. Mr. Garrett also reported Bonita Street had some minor repairs done.

**2. Potential safety modifications to the Granite Dells/Highway 260/Safeway Driveway intersection.**

Safeway Intersection

Chairman Van Camp reported he talked with the Safeway manager and he may attend today's TAB meeting. Member Dye reported her research on this intersection. She noted meeting with the resident located near the Safeway entrance and they were open to the idea of a revised entrance. Member Dalby shared four options studied for this intersection. The Board discussed the ideas presented. They also discussed the holiday traffic. Member Dalby suggested a meeting with Mr. Garrett, before the next TAB meeting, to discuss and revise the intersection concepts. The Board agreed to have this item on the next agenda.

**3. Potential improvements to improve the Colcord Road and Main Street intersection.**

Colcord/Main

Chairman Van Camp suggested re-stripping this intersection. Member Tilley withdrew her motion to table this item so Member Dye could discuss. She suggested keeping this item on the agenda for future consideration.

**4. Potential street improvements to allow increased mobility in Payson.**

Traffic Mobility

Chairman Van Camp stated he would like to see Mud Springs go through to Highway 260. Member Dye would like to see Rumsey continue to McLane. Member Tilley stated she would like to have a work study using Town maps to look at alternative routes that could be used for through streets. Chairman Van Camp suggested working on McLane, Main Street, and Bootleg Alley.

**5. Future TAB discussion items and schedule of future TAB meetings.**

TAB Meetings

The Board agreed to keep the intersection of Colcord and Main on the agenda, along with the Safeway/260 driveway. The Board would like to report the results of the work study meeting they plan to have with Mr. Garrett. The Board agreed to have the next TAB meeting on Wednesday August 4th, 2010 at 4:00 p.m.
