C. SCHEDULED HEARING(S)

1. P11-002 Amendment to the Unified Development Code (UDC)

Filed by: The Town of Payson

Location: Could affect all of Payson

Purpose: To create a new zoning district classification-Education Facilities District, to allow for educational institutions and their ancillary facilities.

Sheila DeSchaaf, AICP Planner II, summarized the staff report.

The Commission asked questions, which were answered by staff.

Chairman Goddard opened the public hearing.

Shirley Dye voiced some concerns regarding communication towers, power transmission and the consideration of a profitable private business for possible solar tube construction.

Tom Loeffler had a concern with the intent of this zoning. He felt an educational zoning was needed but didn't think this proposal addressed it. Mr. Loeffler also felt that the definition of student housing needed to be better defined.

Chairman Goddard explained the reason for this proposed zoning amendment.

Commissioner Mona felt this proposal would afford some protection for commercial/residential uses.

Commissioner Loyd stated that there were a lot of checks and balances that have to be considered before a change in zoning could take place.

Chairman Goddard closed the public hearing.

Motion: Recommend to the Town Council approval of P11-002, a request to prepare the appropriate Unified Development Code amendments that would create a new zoning district classification for educational uses and ancillary facilities.
