

ORDINANCE NO. 807

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, RELATING TO THE PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAX; ADOPTING "THE 2010-2011 AMENDMENTS TO THE TAX CODE OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON" BY REFERENCE; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA:

Section 1. That certain document known as "The 2010-2011 Amendments to the Tax Code of the Town of Payson" ("2010-2011 Amendments"), three copies of which are on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Payson, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution Number 2608 of the Town of Payson, Arizona, is hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2. Any person found guilty of violating any provision of these amendments to the tax code shall be guilty of a class one misdemeanor, punishable as provided in Section 10.99 of the Code of the Town of Payson. Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense punishable as hereinabove described.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance or any part of these amendments to the tax code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. The provisions of Section 1 of the 2010-2011 Amendments shall be effective from and after June 1, 2011. The provisions of Sections 2 through 5 of the 2010-2011 Amendments shall be effective from and after July 29, 2010. The provisions of Section 6 of the 2010-2011 Amendments shall be effective from and after September 30, 2009.

Section 5. The Town of Payson has complied with all of the provisions of A.R.S. §9-499.15 and the amendments adopted by this Ordinance are authorized by Title 42, Chapter 6, Article 2 (Model City Tax Code) of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Section 6. Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Payson, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall become immediately operative and in full force and effect from and after the date of its enactment.


