

RESOLUTION NO. 2659

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 13, 2012, VACATING THE MAY 15, 2012 GENERAL ELECTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson, Gila County, Arizona, held a Primary Election on the 13th day of March, 2012 for the election of a Mayor and three Council Members; and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Payson,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, is adopted as the Official Town of Payson Canvass/Abstract of Vote for the Primary Election of March 13, 2012 and that Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein, is adopted as the March 13, 2012 Primary Election Summary Report.

Section 2. That the total number of ballots cast at said Primary Election was 3105.

Section 3. That the number of ballots to be verified was 0 and the number of ballots found to be ineligible was 41.

Section 4. That the votes cast for the candidates for the office of Mayor were as follows:

Section 8. That the General Election scheduled for May 15, 2012 is hereby vacated.

Section 9. Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Payson, Arizona, and to provide for the orderly succession of elected officials, an emergency is declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
