

RESOLUTION NO. 2654

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (“CDBG”) FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION MEETS THE COMMUNITY’S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the Town of Payson is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program (“CDBG”); and

WHEREAS, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of three Congressional mandated National Objectives; and

WHEREAS, the activities within these applications address a community’s identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of seniors and low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, a grantee of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and federal statutes and regulations,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Payson authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing, for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 CDBG funds, and authorize Kenny J. Evans, Mayor of the Town of Payson, to sign such application and contracts or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds for owner occupied housing rehabilitation and Payson Senior Center improvements (if applicable), and authorize the Mayor and the Town of Payson to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said applications.

Section 2. That the Town of Payson’s application for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low and moderate income benefit for activities justified as benefitting low and moderate income persons, aiding in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight, or addressing an urgent need which poses a threat to health.

Section 3. That the Town of Payson will comply with all State CDBG guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and the certifications contained in the application.


