

ORDINANCE NO. 849

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 95 (AIRPORT) OF THE TOWN CODE RELATING TO THROUGH THE FENCE ACCESS TO THE AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the Town owns and operates the Payson Airport ("the Airport"); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 95 of the Town Code regulates activities at the Airport; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2014, the Airport Advisory Commission reviewed the provisions of Chapter 95 related to Through the Fence Access and made recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend the provisions of Chapter 95 related to Through The Fence Access to the Airport,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PAYSON, ARIZONA, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Definition of "Through The Fence Access" is added to Section 95.01 of the Town Code and shall read as follows:

Through The Fence Access or TTFA – (1) The taxiing of an aircraft on to or off of the Airport via a taxi way and aircraft gate or (2) Utilizing a motor vehicle to transport an aircraft on to or off of the Airport.

Section 2. Section 95.13 of the Town Code is amended and shall read as follows:

95.13 ~~RESIDENTIAL~~ THROUGH THE FENCE ACCESS ACTIVITIES.

(A) ~~Applicability:~~ This section applies to all Through The Fence Access ~~properties located within the Mazatzal Mountain Air Park subdivisions.~~

(B) Mazatzal Mountain Air Park Through The Fence Access.

~~(B)~~ (1) All property owners in a Mazatzal Mountain Air Park subdivision shall enter into an agreement with the town regarding Through The Fence Access. ~~the use of Bravo Gate for access between their residential property and the airport.~~

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~~(C) All property owners as of October 19, 2012 shall execute an appropriate agreement with the town concerning access between their residential property and the airport on or before December 31, 2012.~~

~~(D) (2) When a person purchases developed property within the Mazatzal Mountain Air Park subdivisions, such person shall execute an appropriate agreement with the town regarding Through The Fence Access concerning access between the person's residential property and the airport within 30 days of the property purchase.~~

~~(E) (3) No building permit shall be issued for any property within the Mazatzal Mountain Air Park subdivisions until the property owner has executed an appropriate agreement with the town regarding Through The Fence Access concerning access between his/her residential property and the airport.~~

~~(F) (4) A property owner shall may be exempt from airport access fees if:~~

~~(1) (a) The property owner does not store a legally flyable aircraft on his/her property; or~~

~~(2) (b) A licensed pilot does not reside on the property.~~

(C) All Other Through The Fence Access.

(1) Persons utilizing Through The Fence Access. All persons utilizing Through The Fences Access shall enter an agreement with the town regarding such Through The Fence Access.

(2) Aircraft related businesses Utilizing Through The Fence Access.

(a) Any aircraft related business utilizing Through The Fence Access or whose customers utilize Through The Fence Access shall enter an agreement with the town regarding such Through The Fence Access.

(b) An aircraft related business may be exempt from paying the airport access fee if the owner of each aircraft utilizing Through The Fence Access has an agreement with the Town.

Section 3. Section 95.14 of the Town Code is amended and shall read as follows:

95.14 RESERVED. ~~THROUGH THE GATE ACTIVITIES.~~

~~(A) This section applies to individuals that have an aircraft stored off the airport which the owner intends to transport to the airport by trailer or other means.~~

~~(B) All aircraft owners who intend to bring their portable aircraft onto the airport to use the runway and other facilities shall pay a monthly fee equivalent to a~~

~~tie down fee, shall pass the prescribed driver training course, and shall obtain a gate card for either Alpha Gate or Delta Gate.~~

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.
