

RESOLUTION 2819

A RESOLUTION OF THE PAYSON TOWN COUNCIL, AUTHORIZING THE RIM COUNTRY EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION TO BE THE TOWN'S DESIGNEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING THE UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE SITE LOCATED IN APPROXIMATELY THE 1000 TO 1600 BLOCK OF EAST HIGHWAY 260.

WHEREAS, the United States Forest Service (the "Forest Service") has been authorized by Congress to sell its current Forest Service Site located in approximately the 1000 to 1600 block of East Highway 260 (the "Forest Service Site") to a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Forest Service has indicated that the Town of Payson, in lieu of the Town itself purchasing the Forest Service Site, may authorize a designee for such purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to authorize Rim County Educational Foundation as its designee for the purchase of the Forest Service Site,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND PAYSON TOWN COUNCIL RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The Rim Country Educational Foundation is authorized as the Town's designee for the purpose of purchasing the Forest Service Site located approximately in the 1000 to 1600 block of East Highway 260.
