

RESOLUTION 2824

A RESOLUTION OF THE PAYSON TOWN COUNCIL, CLARIFYING THAT THE COUNCIL INTENDED TO ADOPT ORDINANCE 859A AND RESOLUTION 2408A CONTAINING THE ADDITIONAL AMENDMENT TO SECTION 130.03(C) OF THE TOWN CODE RELATED TO SERVICE OF LIBRARY COMPLAINTS.

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2014 and November 6, 2014, the Town Council held two public hearings on Ordinance 859 and Resolution 2408 amending Chapter 130 of the Town Code; and

WHEREAS, between the two public hearings, it was brought to Town Staff's attention that an additional amendment to Section 130.03(C) (relating to the service of library complaints) was being recommended; and

WHEREAS, prior to the November 6, 2014 public hearing, Town Staff (a) prepared a Supplemental Staff Memo detailing the additional recommended change; and (b) prepared Ordinance 859A and Resolution 2408A which incorporated the additional recommended change; and

WHEREAS, at the November 6, 2014 public hearing, Town Staff explained the additional recommended changes and the amended Ordinance and Resolution that had been prepared; and

WHEREAS, the Council was receptive to the additional change as explained by Staff and contained in the amended Ordinance and Resolution; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Blair moved to approved the Ordinance and Resolution, but did not reference the 'A' versions; and

WHEREAS, it was the Council's intent to adopt the Ordinance and Resolution with the additional change as set forth in 859A and 2408A,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR AND PAYSON TOWN COUNCIL RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

On November 6, 2014, it was the Town Council's intent to adopt Ordinance 859A and Resolution 2408A with the additional amendment discussed at the public hearing. The Council's action of November 6, 2014 is amended to reflect that the Council adopted 859A and 2408A.
