March 4, 2010**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Evans called the meeting to order at approximately 5:30 p.m. in the Town Hall Council Chambers, 303 North Beeline Highway, Payson, Arizona.

ORDINANCE NO. 466 AND THE ZONING CODE FOR THE TOWN OF PAYSON BY REZONING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT 208-214 SOUTH CLARK AND 209 SOUTH GOODNOW ROAD, BEING GILA COUNTY ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NUMBERS 304-04-208 AND 30404-130, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED HERETO, FROM R-1-8MH TO R3. (FOUNDATION FOR SENIOR LIVING REZONING).

Bob Willig owned property in the area and spoke in opposition of the rezoning.

Carol Brown lived in the area and presented the Council with pictures of the street. Ms. Brown believed the street was too small to support the increased traffic and that there would be increased runoff.

Doug Laddell lived in the area and was opposed to the development on Goodnow Road. Mr. Laddell believed the drainage was already bad and the project would make it worse.

Mayor Evans closed the First Reading and Public Hearing.

LaRon Garrett, Public Works Director, explained the airport had its own operating board and the Council had to approve who was appointed to that board.

Debra Galbraith, Town Manager, explained this was a request to negotiate with State Parks to keep Tonto Natural Bridge open.

**Motion:** have the Mayor and/or staff negotiate with the Arizona State Parks Department to continue operation of the Tonto Natural Bridge through October 2010.

Moved by Council Member Ed Blair, seconded by Council Member John Wilson.

Mayor Evans explained that the problem continued to get worse. The State Parks were taking more cuts. Mayor Evans believed the best course of action was to create a series of scenarios to keep the bridge open. A source of funding had been identified. Mayor Evans explained some of the different scenarios and that the Town was not using tax payer money to keep the park open; there were other sources of money to use.

Council Member Wilson added The Friends of the Tonto Natural Bridge would have a booth at the Business Showcase. The Friends of the Tonto Natural Bridge would like to raise as much money as possible as soon as possible. If they don't need the money to support the Bridge they can use the money to promote the Bridge.
