

**TOWN OF PAYSON
PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION
MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING
January 12, 2009**

Vice-Chairman Bedsworth called the duly posted and published public meeting of the Planning and Zoning Commission to order at 3:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Russell Goddard moved, seconded by Jim Scheidt, to approve the minutes of the November 10, 2008, meeting; motion carried 7-0.

Russell Goddard moved, seconded by Jim Scheidt, to approve the minutes of the November 17, 2008, special meeting; motion carried 7-0.

Jim Scheidt nominated Russell Goddard for Chairman and Joel Mona for Vice-Chairman, seconded by Jere Jarrell; motion carried 7-0.

D. SCHEDULED HEARING(S)

1. CUP-157-07 Conditional Use Permit Extension Request
Filed by: Ponderosa Baptist Church, property owner
Location: 212 West Corral Drive
Purpose: To allow an additional five years for a temporary church office use in a R-1 zoning district.

Chairman Goddard read the above application and asked for a staff report.

Ray Erlandsen, Acting Community Development Director, summarized the staff report. Staff recommends approval of the extension request.

The Commission asked questions, which were answered by staff and the applicant.

Chairman Goddard opened the public hearing.

Chairman Goddard closed the public hearing.

Motion: Approve - That the length of this conditional use permit shall be for a period of seven years.

2. P-351-08 Unified Development Code (UDC) Amendment
Filed by: Town of Payson
Location: Could affect all of Payson
Purpose: To amend Section 15-03, Landscaping and Buffering, of the Unified Development Code to combine repetitive language from Chapter 153 of the Town Code as well as revise for simplification and clarification.

Chairman Goddard read the above application and asked for a staff report.

Sheila DeSchaaf, Planner II, summarized the staff report.

Jim Scheidt suggested that the proposed changes to the landscaping provisions be reviewed in sections.

Chairman Goddard stated that this might be an opportunity to review the landscaping requirements for the Town.

Joel Mona commented that he read through it and felt that it was accurate in its presentation.

Sheila DeSchaaf, Planner II, explained what each exhibit covered.

There was further discussion on how the landscaping provisions would be presented to the Council for approval.

Chairman Goddard opened the public hearing.

Chairman Goddard closed the public hearing.

Motion: Recommend to the Town Council approval of P-351-08, an amendment to the Unified Development Code, Section 15-03, Landscaping & Buffering as well as Town of Payson Code of Ordinances Title XV Chapter 153 as attached.

Jere Jarrell expressed his appreciation of Ms. DeSchaaf's hard work on putting this together.

Moved by Joel Mona, seconded by Lori Meyers.

Jim Scheidt asked for the status on Resolution 2458, ADU's. Tim Wright, Deputy Town Attorney, gave an update on the resolution and stated that Council had first

read at last week's meeting and will have second read on January 22. If approved, then it would be in effect 30 days after second read.

Joel Mona asked if there was any reviews in progress regarding impact fees. Tim Wright, Deputy Town Attorney, replied to his knowledge there were none. He stated it was an extremely complicated process and an appropriate study would have to be done.

Chairman Goddard asked staff to review the status of 4 items that were on the previous meeting agenda.
