1. P12-001 Unified Development Code Amendment (UDC)

Purpose: To amend the Unified Development Code (UDC) provisions concerning the parking of vehicles over 1-ton capacity on residential property.

Sheila DeSchaaf, Zoning Administrator, summarized the staff report.

The Commission asked questions, which were answered by staff.

A couple of members of the audience had questions regarding the proposed change, which were answered by staff.

There was discussion regarding the possibility of including a conditional use permit provision, for certain situations, to the proposed revision to the code.

The discussion continued regarding the possibility of adding an option for a conditional use permit to the proposed code amendment.

Motion: Recommend that staff bring back to the Commission the proposed change to the UDC regarding the 1-ton vehicle as submitted with the addition of a Conditional Use option for external storage with appropriate screening.
