

**TOWN OF PAYSON

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING  
March 11, 2013**

**Chairman Loyd called the duly posted public meeting of the Planning and Zoning Commission to order at 3:00 p.m. in the Town Council Chambers.**

1. Public Meeting 1-14-13 Pages 1-4

**C. SCHEDULED HEARING(S)**

1. P12-003 Unified Development Code Amendment  
Filed by: Town of Payson  
Location: Could affect all of Payson  
Purpose: To amend Sections 15-05 and other affected Unified Development Code provisions pertaining to signs.

Doni Wilbanks, Planning Technician, stated that after many meetings with the Commission staff has finalized the draft of the proposed amendments for consideration today. They are shown in exhibits A-F.

Tim Wright, Town Attorney, commented that if this goes forward today then it would go to Council on March 21 for first reading and the second reading would be the first meeting in April. After that it would become effective in May.

Chairman Loyd opened the public hearing.

Several members of the audience spoke in favor of the proposed amendments to the temporary portable signs (swing way) that includes leaving them out seven (7) days. It was noted that these types of signs do work.

Chairman Loyd closed the public hearing.

Motion: To recommend to the Town Council approval of P12-003, an amendment to the Unified Development Code provisions concerning signage as outlined in Exhibits A-F of the staff report.

2. P12-006 Unified Development Code Amendment  
Filed by: Town of Payson  
Location: Could affect all of Payson  
Purpose: To amend Sections 15-02 and other affected Unified Development Code provisions pertaining to mobile storage units, shipping containers, pods, tractor trailer units.

Doni Wilbanks, Planning Technician, stated that staff had drafted proposed amendments for formal consideration today.

Tim Wright, Town Attorney, explained that after the prior meeting staff reviewed some of the issues and the proposed changes are now in draft form.

Chairman Loyd opened the public hearing.

Camille Levy, Executive Director, Time Out Shelter, which includes the Time Out Thrift Shop, stated that she had two (2) concerns; 1) they do have a 30' mobile storage unit behind their building that is used for storage; 2) Big Brothers/Big Sisters has a trailer on the side of the building, which is not on their property.

The Commission asked questions which were answered by the applicant.

Commissioner Scheidt questioned the existing storage units in residential areas and if they would be grandfathered in. Tim Wright, Town Attorney, commented that the term grandfathered or legal non-conforming means they would have to have been legal at some point.

Chairman Loyd closed the public hearing.

Motion: To recommend to the Town Council approval of P12-006, an amendment to the Unified Development Code provisions concerning mobile storage units as outlined in Exhibit A of the staff report.

Moved by Mark Waldrop, seconded by James Scheidt.

Vote: Motion carried 6 - 0

Yes: John Swenson, James Scheidt, Lori Meyers, Jeff Loyd, Mark Waldrop, and Dan Jaeger.

Commissioner Swenson thanked the staff for the work they did on the previous two (2) items.
