




Installing permanent signage on your business?



§154-05**

Portable Signs



Temporary portable signs may be placed in the unimproved portion of the Town's right-of-way or on private property with the permission of the property owner, lessee, or other person lawfully in control of the property with the following restrictions:

- Only one such sign per person or establishment is allowed,
- Such signs may be placed only in commercially zoned areas, and
- Such signs shall not exceed six square feet in size.
- Hanging metal A-frame design only

Requires permit prior to placement.

Directional Signs




Temporary signs that direct a person to a specific location or address:

- All such signs shall be placed within one mile of the address or location being directed to,
- Only one temporary directional sign is allowed per change in direction,
- May be displayed up to 60 days per calendar year,
- Limited to three square feet in size
- May be placed on private property with the permission of the property owner, lessee, or other person lawfully in control of the property or in the unimproved portion of the town's right-of-way.

Requires permit prior to placement.

\$5/each/year

Banners



- Only one banner permit shall be issued per business
- May be manually changed during the display period, i.e., a permitted banner may read "good morning" during the morning hours and be replaced with a banner reading "good afternoon" during the afternoon hours.
- 24 sq. ft. total & 8 ft. max length/height
- Banners shall fabric, pliable plastic, paper, or other light material not enclosed in a rigid frame.
- No appurtenances (balloons, streamers, etc).
- A banner not attached to a building or structure shall include wind cuts.
- If placed in the unimproved portion of the Town's right-of-way, the banner shall only advertise a business/establishment immediately adjacent to the right-of-way where the banner is displayed.
- If displayed upon the Town's right-of-way, banners shall be located a minimum of 15 feet back of or behind the sidewalk or curb.
- If displayed upon private property, shall be located a minimum of three feet back of or behind adjacent public road improvements. During the permitting process, if required for pedestrian or vehicle traffic safety, the minimum setback may be increased up to a total of 15 feet.

Requires permit prior to placement.
