

TOWN OF PAYSON PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, determined that the COVID-19 outbreak presents conditions in Arizona that justified his declaration of a State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America, Donald J. Trump, found and proclaimed that the COVID-19 outbreak in the United States constituted a national emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Mayor of the Town of Payson, as authorized under the current circumstances by Payson Town Code Section 30-22(F), A.R.S. § 26-307, and/or A.R.S. § 26-311, proclaimed an emergency in the Town of Payson; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the Mayor of the Town of Payson issued a proclamation 'Limiting the Operations of Certain Businesses to Slow the Spread of COVID-19'; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, issued Executive Order 2020-36 Stay Healthy, Return Smarter, Return Stronger; and

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2020, the Mayor of the Town of Payson issued a proclamation amending the March 17, 2020 proclamation; and

WHEREAS, this proclamation intends to further amend the March 17, 2020 proclamation; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Payson is committed to both mitigating the economic harm of COVID-19 and ensuring the safety of those in our Town. _____


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Thomas Morrissey, Mayor of the Town of Payson, hereby order as follows:

1. This proclamation hereby amends subsection 3.b. of the proclamation issued on May 16, 2020 as follows:

The suspension of "Call to the Public" shall be lifted to allow for telephonic "Call to the Public" at Town Council meetings. Accommodations will be made to allow members of the public who wish to speak during this time to either call in telephonically or submit their comments to be read aloud during the meeting.
